Under the Program, on (1) \$1,000 scholarship funded annually for up to four years: \$4,000 total, (a minimum 2.5 GPA must be maintained) will be awarded to a graduating high school senior from a volunteer or a family in need that is part of the MESA-OUTREACH, INC. community.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- Seeking graduating high school senior with a record of community volunteerism in nonschool sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- Applicants must plan to attend a two (2) year community college or four (4) year college or university.
- Scholarship funds will be paid during the month of August 2024 directly to the college, not the student. The scholarship funds will be issued to the college or university upon receiving a certificate of enrollment for the fall semester, which includes the Student ID number and Financial Aid Office address.
- Applications must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- Applications must be received by MESA-OUTREACH, INC. no later than March 31, 2024. Late applications will not be accepted.
